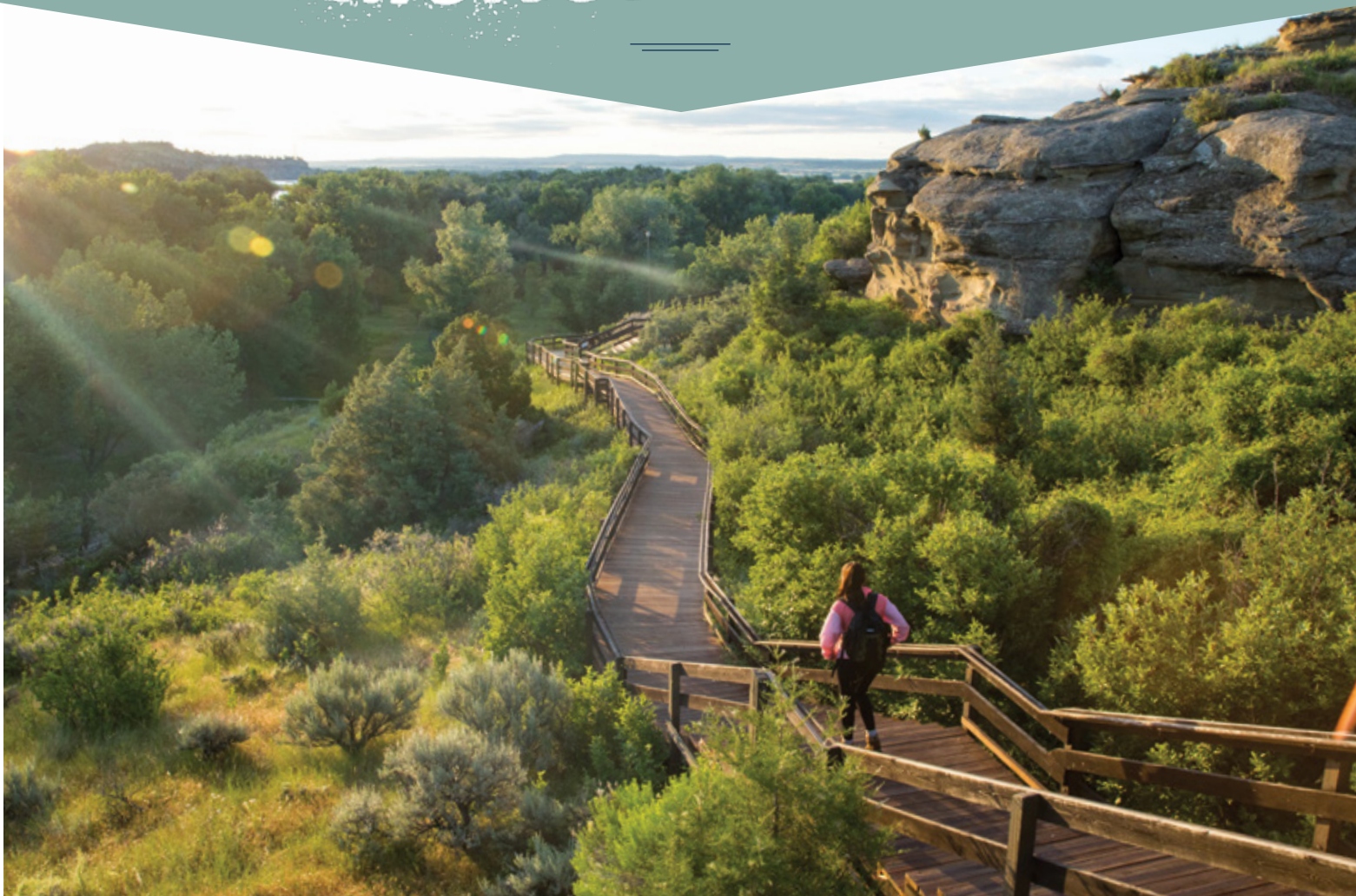

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STATE PARKS AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS



Unique Western history and adventure await you across our state parks and national monuments. Billings is your trailhead as you prepare to take in so many of these fantastic Montana experiences – all easily accessible from town. Whether it's history or scenery, adventure or relaxation, you'll find it in and around Billings.



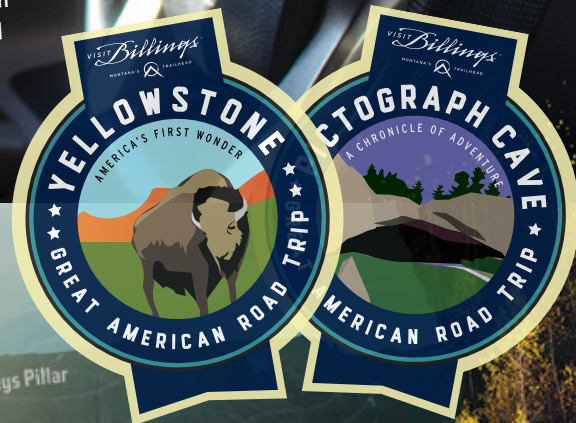
- » Located less than an hour from Billings, Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument memorializes the site of the Battle of the Little Bighorn which took place on June 25-26, 1876 between the United States Seventh Cavalry Regiment led by Lt. Col. George Armstrong Custer, and the Sioux and Cheyenne under the political and spiritual leadership of Sitting Bull. **THE LITTLE BIGHORN BATTLEFIELD NATIONAL MONUMENT** was originally named Custer Battlefield National Monument, but President George H.W. Bush renamed the site in 1991. It is now representative of those who were in the battle: Native Americans and the 7th Cavalry. This historic monument is located near Crow Agency on I-90 E, exit 510 (61.7 miles).
- » President Teddy Roosevelt made Yellowstone the world's first National Park. Geysers, mud pots, painted canyons, wildlife and recreation make this park the best in the world. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, take Highway 212 to **YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK** via Red Lodge and Cooke City (130 miles).
- » Retrace the Lewis and Clark Expedition at **POMPEYS PILLAR NATIONAL MONUMENT**, where William Clark carved his name into this sandstone lookout rock, some of the only remaining physical evidence of the Expedition. Head East on I-94 (28 miles).
- » Outdoor enthusiasts will be in awe of the spectacular **BIGHORN CANYON NATIONAL RECREATION AREA** and **YELLOWTAIL DAM**. The 71-mile-long lake, straddling the Montana-Wyoming border, is one of the largest canyons in the U.S. Follow I-90 to Hardin, then Highway 313 to Fort Smith (90 miles).
- » Visit the log home and farmstead of Chief Plenty Coups at **CHIEF PLENTY COUPS STATE PARK** of the Crow tribe whose bravery, leadership and vision helped bridge the gap between two cultures. Take Highway 416 to Pryor (35 miles).
- » The **PICTOGRAPH CAVE STATE PARK** has been in the making for thousands of years! Explore three caves and see evidence of habitation from 2,000 years ago. Visit the Visitor Interpretive Center and explore ancient artifacts. Hop on I-90 E to Coburn Rd. (7.6 miles).
- » A 64-acre reservoir, **LAKE ELMO STATE PARK** is an urban playground for outdoor adventurers—and four-legged pups. Walk the 1.4-mile nature trail around the lake, cast a line off of Roger's Pier, or set sail on the lake's calm waters. Bring the dogs to play at the 200-square-foot fenced-in dog park. Follow US-87 N to Highway 312 (5.7 miles).
- » Southeast of Billings is the **ROSEBUD BATTLEFIELD STATE PARK**. This National Historic Landmark on the rolling prairie of eastern Montana preserves the site of the June 17, 1876 battle that was a harbinger to the Battle of Little Bighorn. Take I-90 E (109 miles).
- » Travel where the tyrannosaurus and triceratops once roamed at **MAKOSHICA STATE PARK**, Montana's largest state park. Dinosaur fossils have been discovered across the 11,538-acre park. Pop into the onsite visitors center to check out the geology and fossil displays, including a triceratops skull. Follow I-94 E (220 miles).

PRESTON BOYD MOSS

Arriving in town in 1892, Preston Boyd Moss, known as P.B., was a prominent figure in Billings' business development. He was a well-known banker and entrepreneur, starting the forerunner to the *Billings Gazette* and the Billings Utility Company—along with many others. His legacy and impact on Billings' early years is undeniable.

FREDERICK BILLINGS

Frederick Billings made a name for himself during the gold rush, eventually becoming California's first Attorney General. Billings purchased one of the original twelfth interests in the Northern Pacific Railway and served as its president. As the railway expanded, his legacy left a lasting impression. So much so, Billings, Montana was named after him.

YELLOWSTONE KELLY

Luther Sage "Yellowstone" Kelly was one of the most notable American veterans. Kelly was laid to rest in June of 1929 with full military honors overlooking the Yellowstone Valley. Today, the Yellowstone Kelly Interpretive Site sits atop Sword's Rimrock Park and overlooks downtown Billings. The site serves as a memorial to honor Kelly's name and significant contributions.



AGRICULTURE IS MONTANA'S #1 INDUSTRY

Since 1949, Billings is home to three refineries producing about 180,000 barrels of oil every day, with distribution to all nine western states. Not to be forgotten, one of the most important economic factors in Billings is its agriculture industry. Continuing to forge a path of growth, Billings' diverse climate and fertile soil help farmers and ranchers produce a wide variety of quality food products, including the top two commodities—beef and wheat.



TRAILS

As Montana's Trailhead, what better place to hit the trails? Billings offers hundreds of acres of city parks and 47 miles of walking and biking trails that surround the city. Forge your own path to these recommended trails.

Approximately 7 miles of trails are along the legendary **Yellowstone River**. Bring a picnic lunch and dip your toes in the water!

Head to **VisitBillings.com/outdoor-enthusiasts** to access a complete guide of the Billings trail system.



The stretch of trail along the **RIMROCKS** off Airport Road (Highway 3) is a fantastic place to take in the mountains. These sandstone bluffs surround the city and are estimated to be at least 70 million years old. On a clear day, five mountain ranges can be seen from the trail: Pryor, Big Horn, Bull, Crazy and Absaroka-Beartooth. For history buffs, this stretch of trail is a historic mecca. View Yellowstone Kelly Interpretive Site, the legends of Black Otter Trail, Boothill Cemetery and much more!

Billings has 39 city parks and several excellent wild land parks outside city limits. With everything from pools to trails, from tennis to basketball, from picnic tables to playgrounds, there's a park for everyone in Billings. Pick the park for you at billingsparks.org.

Take in history and architecture with a ride, walk or run through **DOWNTOWN BILLINGS**. Check out buildings like the Western Heritage Center (the original Parmly Billings Library) and the Historic Train Depot along Montana Avenue. Dive in a little deeper and see the historic buildings and businesses that began Billings' legacy along with the modern updates that keep Montana's City buzzing today.

GEO-CACHING is another great way to explore the Trailhead. With more than 500 geo-cache treasures in the city of Billings alone, this is an ideal way to get outside, take in the history and the six views. Take home some Montana trinkets and leave behind something from your hometown.



SWORDS RIMROCK PARK

Billings is the trailhead to Montana, and Swords Rimrock Park is the trailhead to Billings. This in-town escape provides breathtaking views, historic icons, paved recreational trails and a Billings experience that should not be missed. Enjoy two miles of paved trails in the park and go on to enjoy the approximate five-mile ride to the river.



OUTDOOR RECREATION

Horseback riding to mountain biking, the paths (and waters) available to explore are endless.

FISHING

Wade, float or fish the shoreline of the state's most famous waterways overflowing with blue ribbon fish, all nearby Billings: Rock Creek, the Stillwater, the Boulder, the Musselshell, the Big Horn and the Yellowstone Rivers, Cooney Dam and Deadman Basin Reservoirs. Learn more about fishing access sites and licenses from Montana Fish Wildlife and Parks by calling 406-247-2940.

Want to hike or mountain bike but don't want to venture too far out of town? No problem! Check out any of these excellent in-town treks within 20 minutes of downtown Billings.

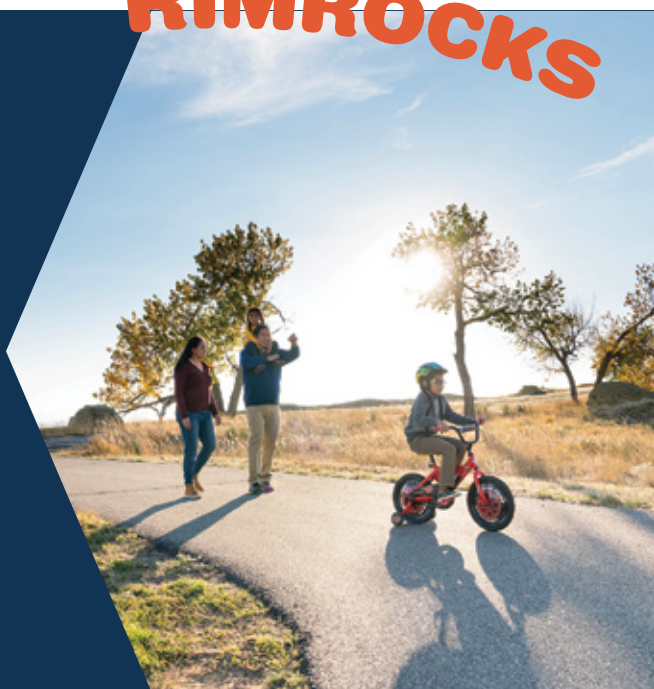
RIVERFRONT PARK and TWO MOON PARK

along the Yellowstone River. These parks boast an abundance of foliage and are a great place to take in the wildlife. A notable site at Two Moon Park is the Weeping Wall which hugs the northwest side of the park and "weeps" water year-round.

ZIMMERMAN PARK, SWORDS RIMROCK PARK and ACTON RECREATIONAL AREA

all offer more challenging hiking or mountain biking options amongst sandstone formations on and around the Rimrocks. These areas provide great views of the city and surrounding areas. The trails in these parks are more technical with cliffs and steep drop-offs existing throughout.

TOP FIVE MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS

Whether you have a few hours or several days in Billings, be sure to make the most of your time. Here is a list of Billings' must-see attractions you won't want to miss. There is something for every adventure type in Billings.

BEARTOOTH HIGHWAY
This scenic pass, just west of Red Lodge, is Montana's most beautiful gateway to Yellowstone Park (125 miles). The highway is open Memorial Day through Labor Day, weather permitting.

LITTLE BIGHORN BATTLEFIELD NATIONAL MONUMENT
This monument commemorates the Sioux and Cheyenne victory over the Seventh Cavalry. The Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument features museum exhibits, an interpretive center, and ranger-led programs.

POMPEYS PILLAR NATIONAL MONUMENT
Home to some of the only remaining physical evidence of the Lewis and Clark Expedition, plus breathtaking views of the Yellowstone River Valley and a terrific interpretive center.

SCENIC DRIVE ALONG THE RIMROCKS
Drive Highway 3 from east to west and take in the forever views that make up Billings from 500 feet above the city.

YELLOWSTONE RIVER
The longest free flowing river in the lower 48 states and a beautiful place to enjoy. Take a leisurely walk or cast in a line – either way the river cannot be missed!

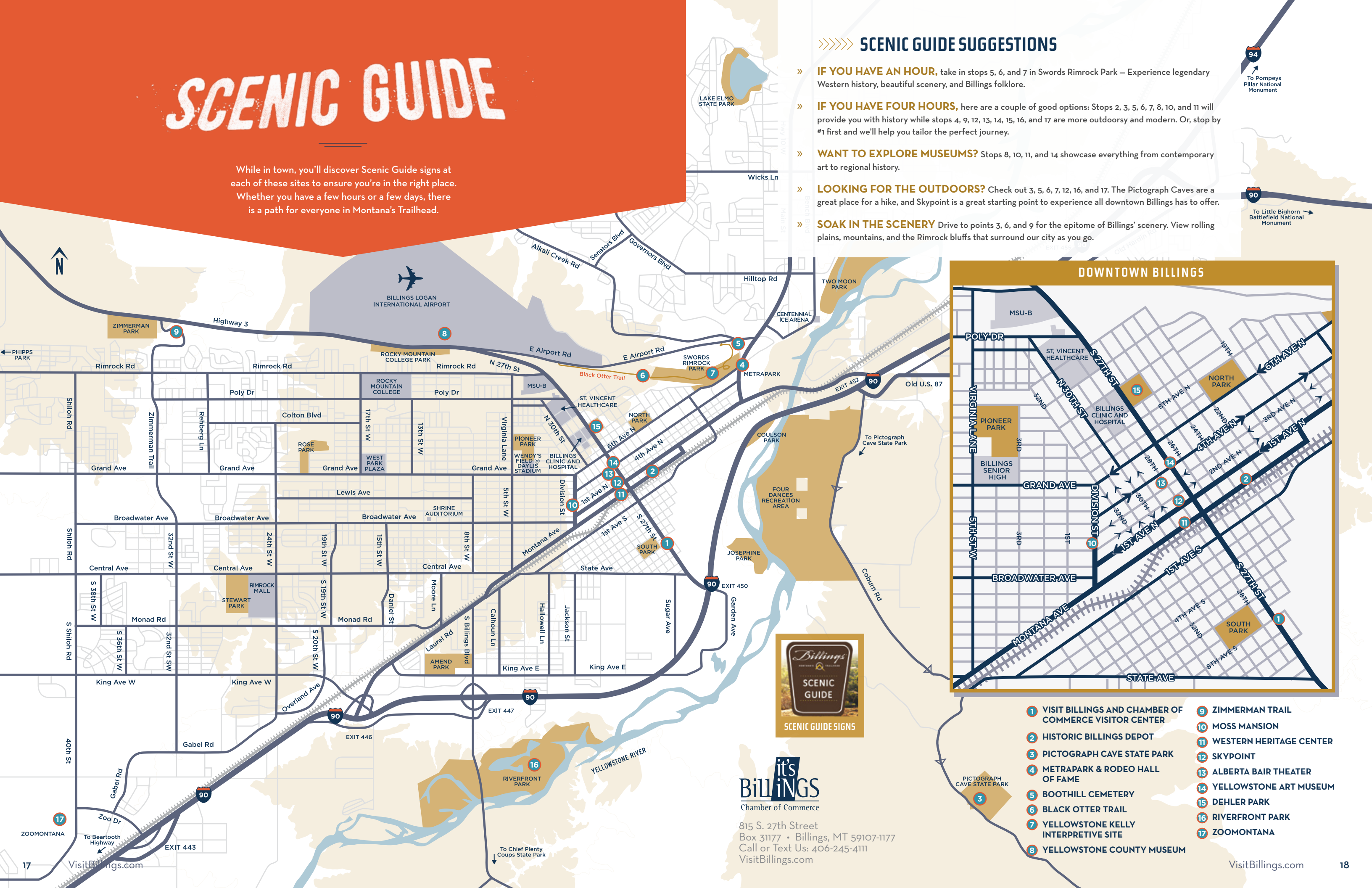


SCENIC GUIDE

- » **IF YOU HAVE AN HOUR**, take in stops 5, 6, and 7 in Swords Rimrock Park — Experience legendary Western history, beautiful scenery, and Billings folklore.
- » **IF YOU HAVE FOUR HOURS**, here are a couple of good options: Stops 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, and 11 will provide you with history while stops 4, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 are more outdoorsy and modern. Or, stop by #1 first and we'll help you tailor the perfect journey.
- » **WANT TO EXPLORE MUSEUMS?** Stops 8, 10, 11, and 14 showcase everything from contemporary art to regional history.
- » **LOOKING FOR THE OUTDOORS?** Check out 3, 5, 6, 7, 12, 16, and 17. The Pictograph Caves are a great place for a hike, and Skypoint is a great starting point to experience all downtown Billings has to offer.
- » **SOAK IN THE SCENERY** Drive to points 3, 6, and 9 for the epitome of Billings' scenery. View rolling plains, mountains, and the Rimrock bluffs that surround our city as you go.

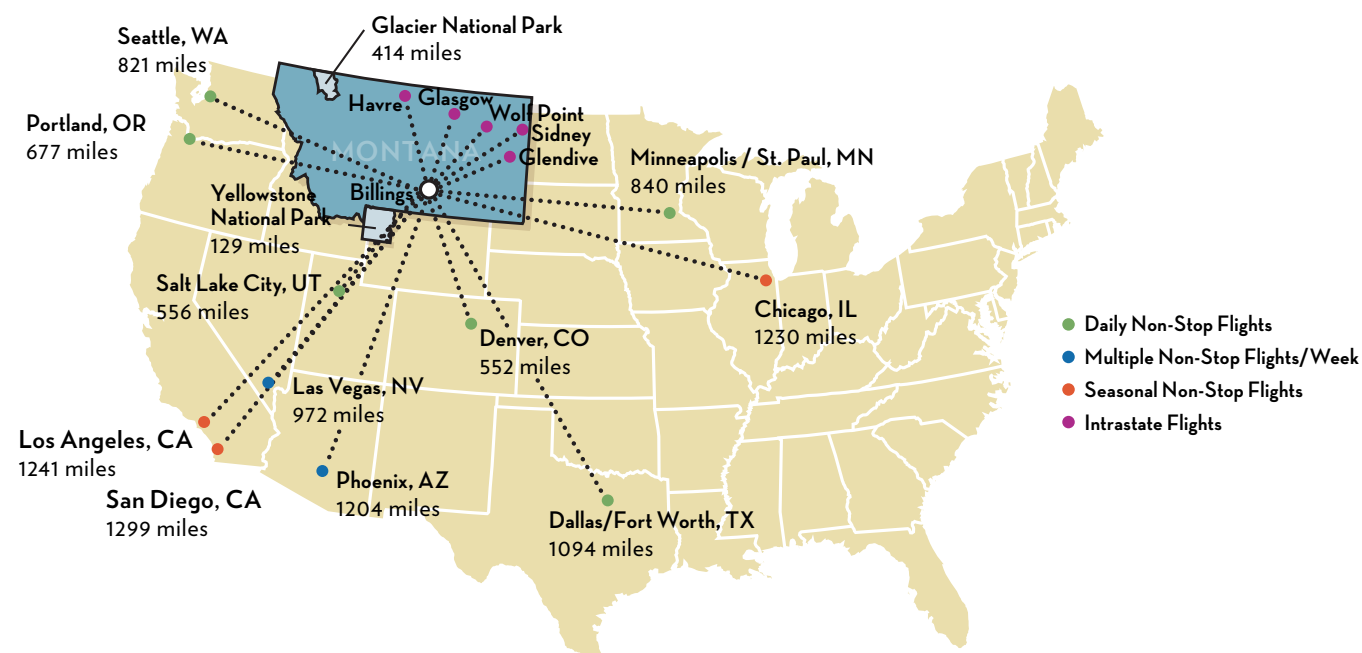

INDIAN COUNTRY

There is great diversity among the twelve tribes located in Big Sky Country in their languages, rituals, histories and governments. Each tribe has a distinct and unique cultural heritage that contributes to modern Montana. Indigenous languages and traditions are alive and well throughout Indian Country, where visitors are welcome to experience the varied customs of each tribe. 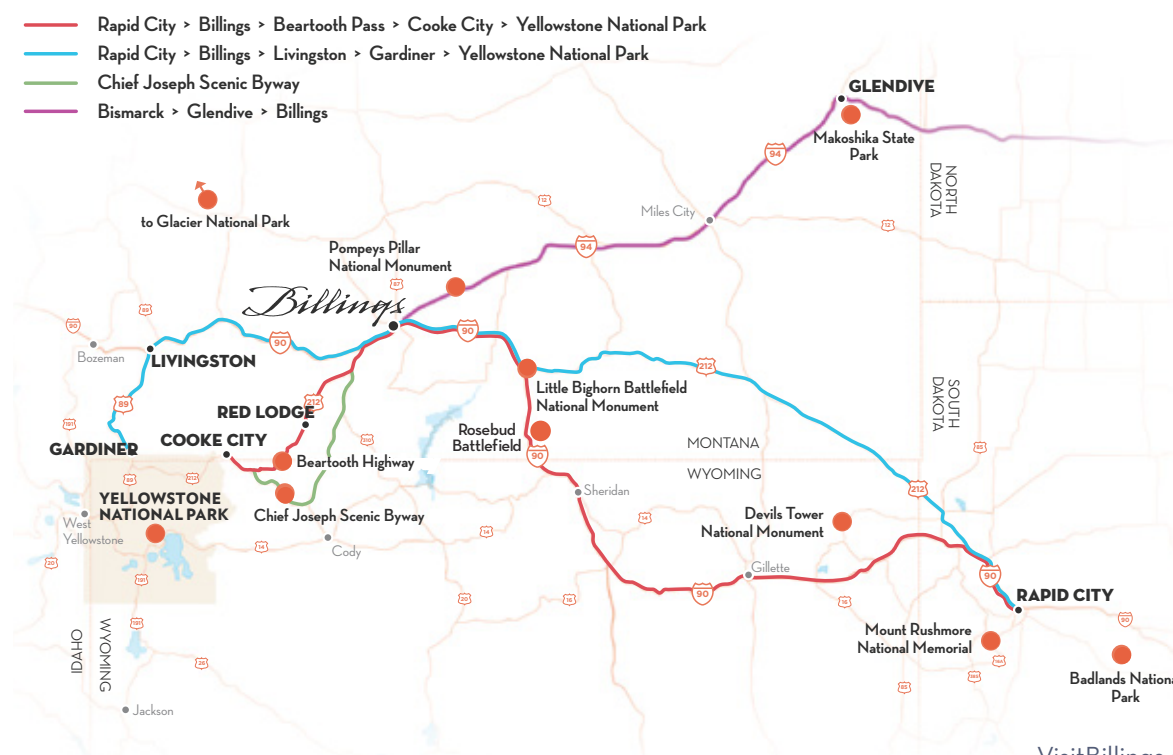

MOTORCYCLE RIDING IN MONTANA is a dream for most bike enthusiasts, and the Billings area is certainly no exception. In 2015, American Motorcyclist magazine included three routes in Montana within the best 15 motorcycle roads in America. Most notably, the number one motorcycling road in America is just 60 miles from Billings: **U.S. HIGHWAY 212**, better known as **BEARTOOTH HIGHWAY**. Glacial lakes, wildlife and views from spectacular heights make the Beartooth a must for every motorcyclist visiting Montana.

INSIDER TIP: many hotels in Billings have bike wash stations.

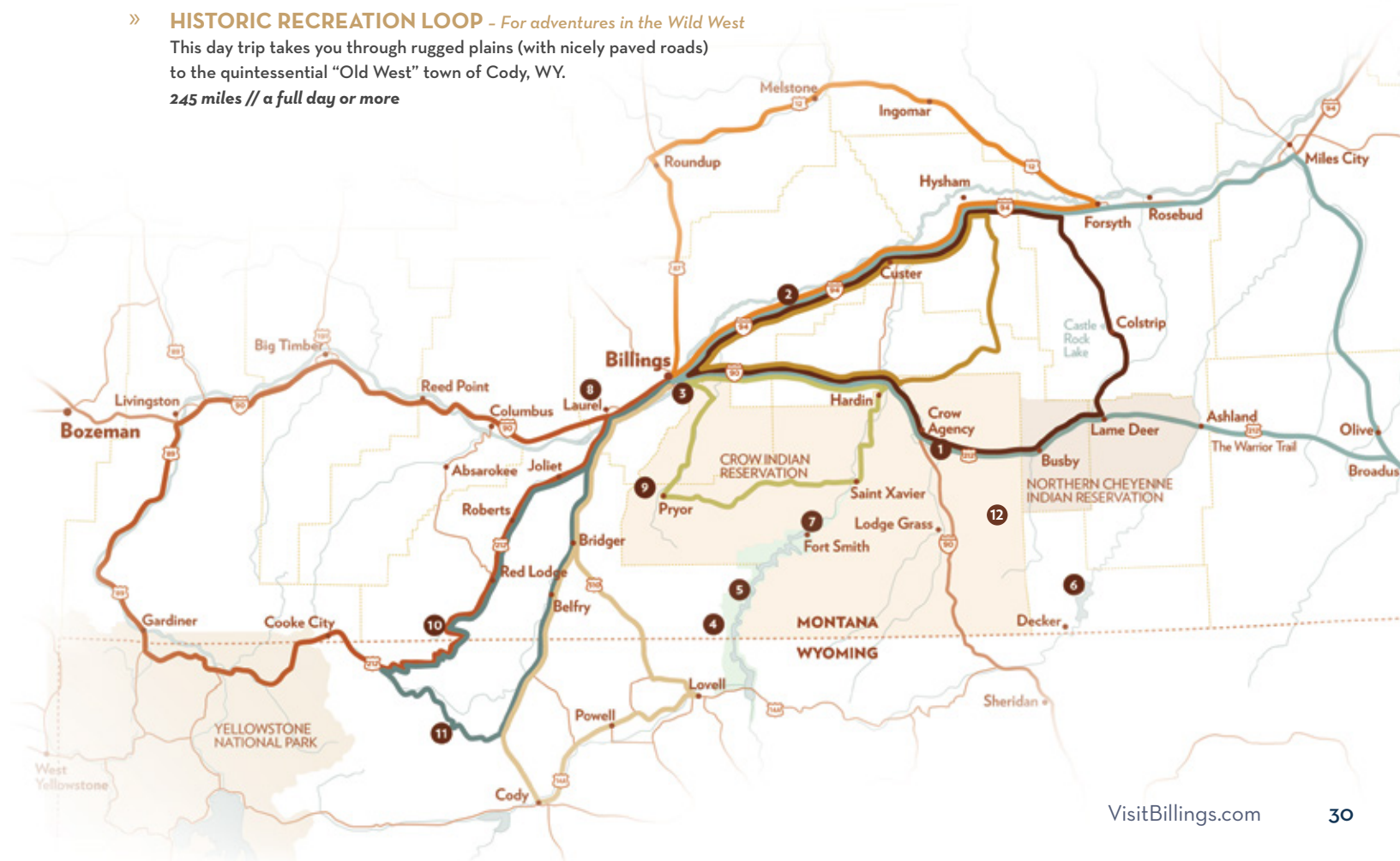
