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

STATE PARKS & NATIONAL MONUMENTS



Unique Western history and adventure await you across our state parks and national monuments. Billings is your trailhead as you prepare to take in so many of these fantastic Montana experiences — all easily accessible from town. Whether it's history or scenery, adventure or relaxation, you'll find it in and around Billings.



- » Located less than an hour from Billings, Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument memorializes the site of the Battle of the Little Bighorn which took place on June 25-26, 1876 between the United States Seventh Cavalry Regiment led by Lt. Col. George Armstrong Custer, and the Sioux and Cheyenne under the political and spiritual leadership of Sitting Bull. THE LITTLE BIGHORN BATTLEFIELD NATIONAL MONUMENT was originally named Custer Battlefield National Monument, but President George H.W. Bush renamed the site in 1991. It is now representative of those who were in the battle: Native Americans and the 7th Cavalry. This historic monument is located near Crow Agency on 1-90 E, exit 510 (61.7 miles).
- President Teddy Roosevelt made Yellowstone the world's first National Park. Geysers, mud pots, painted canyons, wildlife and recreation make this park the best in the world. From Memorial Day to Labor Day, take Highway 212 to YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK via Red Lodge and Cooke City (130 miles).
- » Retrace the Lewis and Clark Expedition at POMPEYS PILLAR NATIONAL MONUMENT, where William Clark carved his name into this sandstone lookout rock, some of the only remaining physical evidence of the Expedition. Head East on I-94 (28 miles).
- Outdoor enthusiasts will be in awe of the spectacular BIGHORN CANYON NATIONAL RECREATION AREA and YELLOWTAIL DAM. The 71-mile-long lake, straddling the Montana-Wyoming border, is one of the largest canyons in the U.S. Follow I-90 to Hardin, then Highway 313 to Fort Smith (90 miles).

- » Visit the log home and farmstead of Chief Plenty Coups at CHIEF PLENTY COUPS STATE PARK of the Crow tribe whose bravery, leadership and vision helped bridge the gap between two cultures. Take Highway 416 to Pryor (35 miles).
- The PICTOGRAPH CAVE STATE PARK has been in the making for thousands of years! Explore three caves and see evidence of habitation from 2,000 years ago. Visit the Visitor Interpretive Center and explore ancient artifacts. Hop on I-90 E to Coburn Rd. (7.6 miles).
- » A 64-acre reservoir, LAKE ELMO STATE PARK is an urban playground for outdoor adventurers—and four-legged pups. Walk the 1.4-mile nature trail around the lake, cast a line off of Roger's Pier, or set sail on the lake's calm waters. Bring the dogs to play at the 200-square-foot fenced-in dog park. Follow US-87 N to Highway 312 (5.7 miles).
- Southeast of Billings is the ROSEBUD BATTLEFIELD STATE PARK. This National Historic Landmark on the rolling prairie of eastern Montana preserves the site of the June 17, 1876 battle that was a harbinger to the Battle of Little Bighorn. Take I-90 E (109 miles).
- » Travel where the tyrannosaurus and triceratops once roamed at MAKOSHIKA STATE PARK, Montana's largest state park. Dinosaur fossils have been discovered across the 11,538-acre park. Pop into the onsite visitors center to check out the geology and fossil displays, including a triceratops skull. Follow I-94 E (220 miles).

YELLOWSTONE SCENIC HIGHWAY

Forge your own path to excitement as you meander along the secluded back roads and monumental highways to Yellowstone National Park, Beartooth Highway and beyond, for a road trip experience that puts adventure in the driver's seat.

Billings isn't just Montana's Trailhead, it is the gateway to Yellowstone's Most Scenic Route via the Beartooth Highway.

Less than an hour from Billings, the Beartooth Highway provides breathtaking vistas from start to finish, guiding roadtrippers through the most beautiful entrance into Yellowstone - the nation's first national park.

Marvel at a volcano's hidden power rising up in colorful hot springs, mudpots, and geysers. Explore mountains, forests, and lakes to watch wildlife and witness the drama of the natural world unfold. Experience the history that led to the conservation of our national treasures "for the benefit and enjoyment of the people."

An optional Yellowstone National Park route from Billings, also scenic, is Interstate 90 westward to Highway 89 south. Travel through beautiful Paradise Valley into the north entrance of Yellowstone at Gardiner.







PRESTON BOYD MOSS

Arriving in town in 1892, Preston Boyd Moss, known as P.B., was a prominent figure in Billings' business development. He was a well-known banker and entrepreneur, starting the forerunner to the *Billings Gazette* and the Billings Utility Company—along with many others. His legacy and impact on Billings' early years is undeniable.

FREDERICK BILLINGS

Frederick Billings made a name for himself during the gold rush, eventually becoming California's first Attorney General. Billings purchased one of the original twelfth interests in the Northern Pacific Railway and served as its president. As the railway expanded, his legacy left a lasting impression. So much so, Billings, Montana was named after him.

YELLOWSTONE KELLY

Luther Sage "Yellowstone" Kelly was one of the most notable American veterans. Kelly was laid to rest in June of 1929 with full military honors overlooking the Yellowstone Valley. Today, the Yellowstone Kelly Interpretive Site sits atop Sword's Rimrock Park and overlooks downtown Billings. The site serves as a memorial to honor Kelly's name and significant contributions.



AGRICULTURE IS MONTANA'S #1 INDUSTRY

Since 1949, Billings is home to three refineries producing about 180,000 barrels of oil every day, with distribution to all nine western states. Not to be forgotten, one of the most important economic factors in Billings is its agriculture industry. Continuing to forge a path of growth, Billings' diverse climate and fertile soil help farmers and ranchers produce a wide variety of quality food products, including the top two commodities—beef and wheat.

TRAILS

As Montana's Trailhead, what better place to hit the trails? Billings offers hundreds of acres of city parks and 47 miles of walking and biking trails that surround the city. Forge your own path to these recommended trails.

Approximately 7 miles of trails are along the legendary **Yelowstone River**. Bring a picnic lunch and dip your toes in the water!




The stretch of trail along the RIMROCKS off Airport Road (Highway 3) is a fantastic place to take in the mountains. These sandstone bluffs surround the city and are estimated to be at least 70 million years old. On a clear day, five mountain ranges can be seen from the trail: Pryor, Big Horn, Bull, Crazy and Absaroka-Beartooth. For history buffs, this stretch of trail is a historic mecca. View Yellowstone Kelly Interpretive Site, the legends of Black Otter Trail, Boothill Cemetery and much more!

Billings has 39 city parks and several excellent wild land parks outside city limits. With everything from pools to trails, from tennis to basketball, from picnic tables to playgrounds, there's a park for everyone in Billings. Pick the park for you at billingsparks.org.

Take in history and architecture with a ride, walk or run through DOWNTOWN BILLINGS. Check out buildings like the Western Heritage Center (the original Parmly Billings Library) and the Historic Train Depot along Montana Avenue. Dive in a little deeper and see the historic buildings and businesses that began Billings' legacy along with the modern updates that keep Montana's City buzzing today.

GEO-CACHING is another great way to explore the Trailhead. With more than 500 geo-cache treasures in the city of Billings alone, this is an ideal way to get outside, take in the history and the six views. Take home some Montana trinkets and leave behind something from your hometown.



SWORDS RIMROCK PARK

Billings is the trailhead to Montana, and Swords Rimrock Park is the trailhead to Billings. This in-town escape provides breathtaking views, historic icons, paved recreational trails and a Billings experience that should not be missed. Enjoy two miles of paved trails in the park and go on to enjoy the approximate five-mile ride to the river.

ARONSON AVE

ZIMMERMAN PARK

Head less than five miles down the road from the Trailhead for sandstone hiking and biking loop tracks with great views of the city. Bring your pup along for the adventure!

4.7 miles from the TRAILHEAD

AIRPORT RD

BLACK OTTER TRAIL

A road only to be traversed by hearty vehicles, this is best explored by bike or on foot and offers great views of the city.

BOOTHILL CEMETERY

A historic cemetery with mostly unknown gravesites from the historic Coulson community.

SACRIFICE

E ALKALI CREEK RD

The cliffs surrounding Billings are composed of fine-grained sand and silty mud deposited 70 to 80 million years ago in offshore bars of a great inland sea

TRAILHEAD

Park your vehicle, hop on the trail and take a moment to breathe in the beauty that lays before you. Five mountain ranges meet your eyes as you look out: Pryor, Big Horn, Bull, Crazy and Absaroka-Beartooth. Downtown Billings is nestled below historic icons and forever views await.

YELLOWSTONE KELLY INTERPRETIVE SITE


Truly a man of the frontier, "Yellowstone" Kelly requested to be laid to rest in Montana, thus this iconic veteran is buried here.

YELLOWSTONE RIVER

The longest running undammed river in the United States runs through our back door. Along the river's 678 miles are changes in water temperature, turbidity (sediment) and fish species. Historically known for Lewis & Clark's use of it.

OUTDOOR RECREATION

A notable site at Two Moon Park is the Weeping Wall which hugs the northwest side of the park and "weeps" water year-round.





>>>>> TOP FIVE MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS

Whether you have a few hours or several days in Billings, be sure to make the most of your time. Here is a list of Billings' must-see attractions you won't want to miss. There is something for every adventure type in Billings.

BEARTOOTH HIGHWAY

This scenic pass, just west of Red Lodge, is Montana's most beautiful gateway to Yellowstone Park (125 miles). The highway is open Memorial Day through Labor Day, weather permitting.

LITTLE BIGHORN BATTLEFIELD NATIONAL MONUMENT

This monument commemorates the Sioux and Cheyenne victory over the Seventh Cavalry. The Little Bighorn Battlefield National Monument features museum exhibits, an interpretive center, and ranger-led programs.

POMPEYS PILLAR NATIONAL MONUMENT

Home to some of the only remaining physical evidence of the Lewis and Clark Expedition, plus breathtaking views of the Yellowstone River Valley and a terrific interpretive center.

SCENIC DRIVE ALONG THE RIMROCKS

Drive Highway 3 from east to west and take in the forever views that make up Billings from 500 feet above the city.

YELLOWSTONE RIVER

The longest free flowing river in the lower 48 states and a beautiful place to enjoy. Take a leisurely walk or cast in a line – either way the river cannot be missed!






WANT TO EXPLORE MUSEUMS? Stops 8, 10, 11, and 14 showcase everything from contemporary art to regional history.

BILLINGS BREW TRAIL

MONTANA'S ONLY WALKABLE BREWERY TRAIL is located in the heart of downtown Billings. This self-guided tour is made up of six breweries, two distilleries and one cider house, all within easy walking distance. Take this 1.5-mile brewery route and enjoy historic sites along the way.



Thirsty Street at the Garage

Thirsty Street at the Garage is home to the Thirsty Street Brewing Co. main brewing operations, where we brew and package our craft beer. Offerings include a variety of 16 styles from light to dark-colored ales, hoppy ales, gluten reduced ales, and sours. The Garage is a great live music venue too-hosting local and touring acts on the weekends.

Montana Brewing Co.

Your last stop is at Montana Brewing Company. If you're hungry, enjoy some dinner and try Custer's Last Stout for dessert. They're open late, so no rush when you're here.

Thirsty Street Brewing Co.Taproom & Bottle Shop

This location hosts Thirsty Street's barrel-aging program and a taproom featuring the same great Thirsty Street Brewing Co. brews, guest taps, cider, kombucha, wine by the glass, and a curated wine and bottle selection. A quick and easy snack menu will satisfy that beer-drinking hankering, but you can also bring your own grub of choice. A fun feature includes a game room with free billiards, darts, and shuffleboard. 

MOTORCYCLE RIDING IN MONTANA is a dream for most bike enthusiasts, and the Billings area is certainly no exception. In 2015, American Motorcyclist magazine included three routes in Montana within the best 15 motorcycle roads in America. Most notably, the number one motorcycling road in America is just 60 miles from Billings: U.S. HIGHWAY 212, better known as BEARTOOTH HIGHWAY. Glacial lakes, wildlife and views from spectacular heights make the Beartooth a must for every motorcyclist visiting Montana. INSIDER TIP: many hotels in Billings have bike wash stations.


